The Bible tells us that this woman's life had become toxic with sin and compromise, yet Jesus offered her special living water... the very same water that the prophet Jeremiah promised almost 600 years earlier that restores relationship with God and gives life forever and ever. This water is the Holy Spirit of God who will live in all those who come to Jesus.

Jesus didn't condemn the woman. Instead he gave her hope. And Jesus is offering the same water to you. Would you like a spiritual detox? Then come to Jesus. Pray to him and ask him to cleanse you completely and help you to live with Him forever.

Prayer: Dear God, please detox me from sin and help me to live with you forever.

Verse: Jesus said: "whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."
